CPAW team of planners, foresters, and researchers work with the community for one year



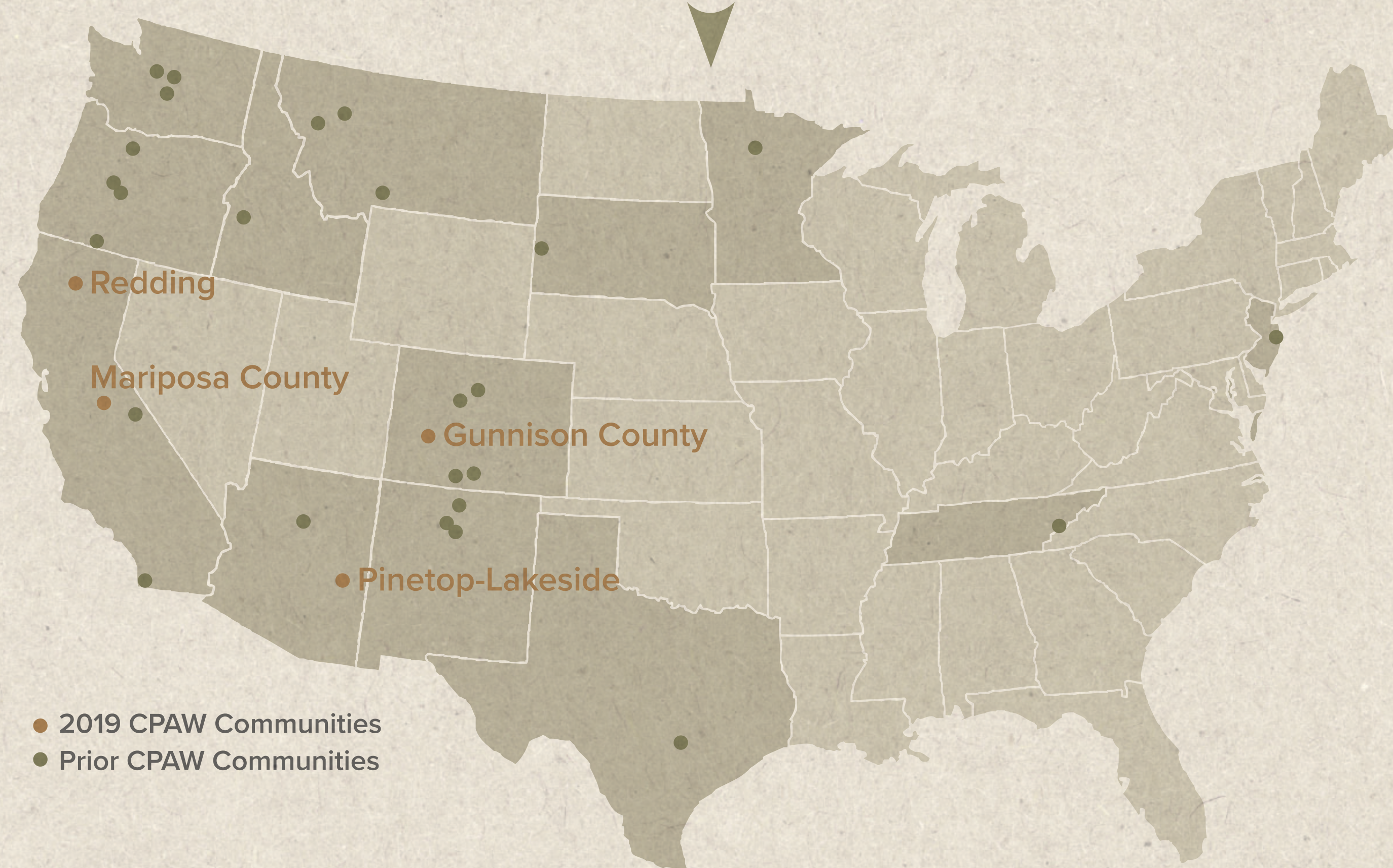
Result is local, customized planning recommendations and tools

CPAW PROCESS

The CPAW team customizes its process to meet each community's unique needs. It typically takes one year, with ongoing support as needed.

PHASE 1
Identify community needs and stakeholders.

PHASE 2
Assess community conditions and documents.

PHASE 3
Draft and refine recommendations with stakeholders.

PHASE 4
Present final report.

Support implementation as needed/funded.
